Schedule of Horticulture Classes

FREE entry to all classes

Rules

1. Classes 1-30 and 05 must be grown by exhibitor (Class 20 must be from home reared chickens).
2. Carrots & Parsnips must have 1" to 2" foliage.
3. Beans must have some stalk.
4. Tomatoes must have calyces.
5. Any suitable vase or container may be used for flower displays.
6. Paper plates will be provided for fruit & vegetable classes.
7. Covers will be provided for bake-off entries.
8. Entries can be removed from the horticulture tent once judging is complete, if the exhibitor wishes.
9. If you wish to keep your entries please remove them from the horticulture tent by 16.30 on Sunday the 8th of September.
- 10. All exhibits must be booked in at the Horticulture Tent between 10.00 and 12.00 on Saturday 7th of September.**
11. The tent will be closed for judging between 12:00 and 13:00 on Saturday

Class 33: Honey Cake – Recipe provided over leaf. Bake in a loaf tin.

Class 34: 4 (moon) Rock Cakes – own recipe.

Class 35: 4 Brownies – own recipe.

Class 36: 1 Loaf of Bread (handmade, not bread machine)

Class 37: 1 x 1lb Jam – own recipe

****INTRODUCING THE JANE HEIGHTON AWARD:**

New to the festival, in recognition of Jane's enthusiasm and commitment to the festival, a new prize will be awarded to the winner of class 32; Best Victoria Sponge.

Honey Cake Recipe

A festival classic, made to the traditional recipe;

280g (10oz) SR flour, 170g (6oz) Honey, 113g (4oz) butter or margarine, 113g (4oz) sultanas, 2 medium eggs, a pinch of salt.

Pre heat oven to 150c, 300f, Gas mark 4 (adjust for your oven)

Method: Cream the butter and honey. Beat the eggs and add them alternately with the sifted flour and salt (saving a little flour to add later with the sultanas). Beat. Add a little milk if needed. Fold in sultanas and remaining flour and stir well. Pour into a prepared 180mm (2lb) loaf tin and bake for approximately 50 minutes to 1 hour.
